Rules for the Admission

- 1) The applicant may apply for admission only through the prescribed application form, accompanying with this prospectus.
- 2) The applicant must apply within the duration prescribed by the college.
- 3) The applicant must fulfill / enter the full and correct information in the application form.
- 4) The following documents (duly attested photostat copies) must accompany with the prescribed application form.
 - i) Marklist
 - ii) Leaving / Transfer Certificate (TC)
(Original Certificate in institute last attended. Duplicate TC will not be entertained)
 - iii) Character Certificate.
 - iv) Employer's Certificate (If the applicant is in service)
 - v) Migration Certificate : If the applicant comes from other university or state board, he/she has to produce a Migration certificate (Latest by 1 September signed by registrar of university from which he/she has migrated and also pay the immigration fee as prescribed by the university.)
 - iv) Caste Certificate (for claiming benefits, meant for backward categories)
 - v) Latest passport sized photograph.
 - vi) Aadhar Card Xerox
- 5) The applications received within the prescribed days, will be scrutinized and a list of eligible students will be put up on the **College Notice Board**. The list will be prepared according to the **merit** and the rules of reservations for various castes and categories.
- 6) Students finding positions in the merit list, will have to confirm their admission within the stipulate days.
- 7) The selected student will have to confirm the admission by submitting all the relevant original documents and paying the full fees at the college office.
- 8) In case a student has been asked to attend the interview, he/she will have to do so at his / her own expenses.
- 9) The students desirous to be admitted in B.A. Sem-III and Sem-V according to the ATKT rule, they should have minimum qualification according to the notification no. 10 of S.G.B. Amravati University, Amravati.
- 10) The students who have passed D.T.Ed (Two year course) or M.C.V.C. (Two years course) are eligible for the admission of B.A. I
- 11) The Principal or admission committee hold the right for the final decision of the admission process.

Note :- The above fees are subjected to change by the University / Govt./ college. The increase in fees will be binding to the students.

Important Instruction for fees

After having sought confirmed admission, it is obligatory for the student to pay the full term fee in a stipulated time.

The name of a student may be struck off from the college roll or liable to a fine or he / she will not be permitted to appear for the University exam, If he/she fails to pay the fees before the date declared by the college. It will be presumed on admission that the student concerned and their parents or guardians have read and concurred with this rule. Hence they are responsible for above notice about fees.

A student will have to pay full total fees in the installment in the month of December, January and February of the academic year. This fee must be deposited before the commencement of University exam.

The installment facility to pay fees of the college is only for the regular students of the college. For the payment of fees student must get a valid receipt of the fees from the college office.

compilation stage, the scholar must obtain 60% marks in the aggregate)

(Promotion to next higher class Annual Income limit : Rs. 1,50,000/-)
- 3) Govt. of India post S.S.C. scholarship for the B.C. (S.C., S.T., N.T. etc.)
- 4) Freeship OBC concession
(Annual Income limit Rs. 1,00,000/- to Rs. 4,00,000/-)
- 5) Govt. of India National Scholarship
(As per Govt. Rules)
- 6) State Govt. merit scholarship
- 7) Merit scholarship for meritorious rural students
- 8) Scholarship for the children of freedom fighters (Minimum 50% marks in the exam.)
- 9) Scholarship for Physically Challenged Students
(Certificate from the Civil Surgeon must accompany with the application form)
- 10) GOI OBC Scholarship
(Annual Income limit : Rs. 1,00,000/-)

Rules of Conduct and Discipline

- 1) **Discipline :-** The college maintains strict discipline and expect rules to be followed by every student in the college campus and outside. Students must obey the instructions of the principal. Students found violating the rules of the college administration or behaving in an undisciplined manner will have their names removed from the college rolls.
- 2) **Attendance :** As per the university rules, every student is required to attend 80% of the lectures (Theory and Practicals taken together) The student having an attendance below 80% will not be permitted to appear for the University examination. The students remaining absent without genuine reasons will have to pay a fine as decided by the college.
- 3) **Identity Card :** It is essential for every college student to wear college uniform with Identity Card. The Identity Card will be given by the college. If you lose it, you will have to pay Rs. 50/- for a duplicate Identity Card.
- 4) The use of mobile phone is strictly prohibited in the college campus.
- 5) **College Uniform ;** For Girls ; Salwar Kurta for Boys ; Shirt & Pant. the colours of college uniform should be in accordance with the norms prescribed by the college authorities.
- 6) Students should use college books, room furniture, fans,

laboratory, equipment of the college properly, and carefully. The cost of any damage done would be recoverable from the student either individually or collectively as the case may be.

- 7) Students are prohibited from forming association / organisations and from holding functions in the college. Violation of rules will promote severe disciplinary action.
- 8) The rules of SGB Amravati University will be applicable to all students of the college.
- 9) Prohibition of Raging : According to Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act, No. 33, 15th May 1999 "RAGGING" is strictly prohibited. Any student convicted of an offence under section 4 of Ragging Act No. 33 shall be dismissed from the college. If the student is found guilty in such cases his / her admission shall be terminated from the college.
- 10) Smoking and Gutkha chewing are strictly prohibited in the campus, offenders shall be liable to face legal action.
- 11) Students must read the notices displayed on the notice board of the college. The students failing to do so will be responsible for the loss.
- 12) Students must ensure themselves whether they are eligible for the scholarship or not. He / She will be responsible for any loss in this regard. Students should fill all forms and submit them to the college with necessary documents on or before the last date.

Co-curricular and Extra-curricular Activities

1) College Examination :

Besides the University examination two unit tests one in each term and terminal examinations in the months of November and February will be held. The student remains absent for these examination is liable to be fined. All the rules framed by the college examination committee will be binding to all students.

2) Seminar / Group Discussion :

One seminar / group discussion will be held for every class in every subject, as specified in Annual Plan.

3) Societies :

The college has many societies which organize various activities throughout the year. Inauguration, Lectures, Seminars, debate, cultural committee are some of them. Educational tours are also organized.

4) Physical Education :

The students not participating in NSS or inter-collegiate sports competitions are required to attend classes of physical training. Nevertheless the students in full time employment or those having physical disability or students above 26 years of age may be exempted only after permission of the principal.

5) Games and Sports :

The college has a vast playground with a coaching for various games. The students may in various sports competitions only after being selected by the college selection committee.

6) NSS :

The NSS unit of college accommodates 150 (selected) college students. The students admitted to the NSS unit will have to obey the rules of NSS. It is compulsory for the students to be a part of the unit for two years and to attend one special camp to be eligible for incentive marks and certificate.

7) College Magazine “Gramjyoti”

The college brings out an issue of the magazine “Gramjyoti” which contains the best contributions of the students. The magazine is sent to University for the inter-collegiate competition of college magazine at the end of the session.

8) Wall Magazine : (Teacher-in-charge Dr. P. R. Jadhao & Dr. P. D. More):

The college provides the facility of a wall magazine '**Antarnaad**' for Marathi subject and '**Insight**' for English subject in which any bonafide college student may contribute his / her article / piece / painting for display.

Facilities available in the college campus**1) College Library :**

The college has a computerized library with a rich collection of books & Internet facility. It has a spacious reading room, text books, reference books, journals, periodicals, and e-journals are available in the college library. There is also the facility of book bank scheme, student can avail of this facility as per the rules and regulations notified from time to time in the library. No student will be allowed entry into the library without the identity card. The student is required to return all the library books in the last week of February. However the students can borrow the books thereafter the students can borrow the books thereafter by depositing the full price of the books to be borrowed. Decisions to this effect will be

governed by the directives of the principal to the librarian. Beside college library each department has its personal library.

2) Gymnasium :

The college has a spacious gymnasium with sophisticated equipment. Students may use it during the scheduled hours, only under the guidance of the instructor.

3) Parking Space :

The college provides parking space for students vehicles. However the college does not undertake the responsibility of the compensation in the event of the loss of vehicle due to theft.

The college runs classes for remedial coaching for poor performers so as to provide them with assistance to keep pace with their fellow students and to instill confidence into them.

The college established a language laboratory to enhance communication skills. A UGC sponsored career-oriented course in communicative skills in English has already been introduced by the college.
